Batteries

Paint Aerosols Accepted

Paint aerosols of all types, including automotive, craft and industrial products

Paint Products Not Accepted

The following types of paint and paint related products are excluded from the program:

- Unidentifiable or unlabelled containersPaints or wood
- •Paints or wood preservatives that are registered as a pesticide under the pest control act (has P.C.P. Reg. # on label) e.g. marine antifouling paint, should be treated as a pesticide
- Craft paint (non-aerosol)Automotive paint (non-
- •Automotive paint (non-aerosol)
- •Industrial paints & finishes (e.g. baked-on, heat resistant etc.)
- •2-part or component paints containing catalyst or activator
- •Roof patch or repair
- Tars
- •Tar-based or bitumen based product
- •Traffic or line marking paint
- Quick drying paint
- Resins
- Paint thinners, mineral spirits or solvents
- Deck cleaners
- Colorants and Tints
- Caulking compound, epoxies, glues or adhesives
- Brushes, rags and rollers

Paint Products Not Accepted cont.

- Improperly sealed paint containers
- Paint containers with poor integrity (e.g. badly rusted cans) or leaking
- Bulging containers
- Resins
- Deck cleaners
- Colorants and Tints
- Caulking compound, epoxies, glues or adhesives
- •Brushes, rags and rollers
- •Improperly sealed paint containers

Container Limits

To ensure that depots are not overwhelmed, we ask that you observe the following voluntary limits of 10 containers (or 50 spray paint containers) per visit. We currently accept consumer paint in the following container sizes:

- •Paint up to 25 litres
- •Aerosol paint spray cans (660 grams or 24 oz.)

Flammable Liquids

Must have a flame symbol or phrase similar to "keep away from open spark or flame" on the label.

Examples:

- Liquids only
- Paint thinners
- Other solvents
- Camp fuels

Flammable Liquids cont. Examples cont.:

- •Liquid adhesives with flammable symbol
- •Other flammables or solvents that have the flame symbol or wording similar to "keep away from open spark or flame"

Maximum container size: Flammables 10 Litres

Pesticides (Domestic)

•Consumer pesticides that have both the poisonous (skull & cross bones) symbol and Pest Control Product (PCP) number.

Maximum container size: Pesticides 10 Litres

Gasoline

- Gasoline in approved ULC containers only
- Maximum container size accepted is 25 litres
- •Containers cannot be returned

Consumer products only. No industrial or specialty products.

Products Not Accepted

- Products that cannot be identified (unknowns)
- Products that are leaking or improperly sealed
- Commercial, industrial or agricultural products
- •Cosmetics, health and beauty aids
- •Insect repellents, disinfectants and pet products

<u>Products Not Accepted</u> cont.

- •Diesel, propane, butane fuels
- Fertilizer
- Acids, cleaners, bleach, and other corrosive materials

Accepted Lights

Fluorescent tubes (straight, curved, U, circular, square etc.)
UV and germicidal
Incandescent and halogen
Compact fluorescent
lights (CFLs)
Light emitting diodes
(LEDs)
Ultra High Performance
(UHP)(replacement
projector lamps)
High-intensity discharge
(HIDs)

Maximum Return Limit

Maximum limit for return at one time in the consumer collection system is a combined total of 16 fluorescent tubes and/or a combined total of 16 other bulb types (i.e. any combination of CFL, HID etc. to a total of 16).

Batteries

Rechargeable batteries weighing up to 5 kg each, including Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-Ion), Nickel Zinc (Ni-Zn) and Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb). We also accept alkaline, lithium primary and carbon-zinc batteries.
