

DRYWALL ACCEPTANCE GUIDELINES

Please note: To ensure employee and customer safety; strict acceptance guidelines need to be met prior to dumping drywall within our facility. Samples that are taken by FRR staff will be filed with FRR. In the event of asbestos containing drywall being received; all samples will be tested to determine the origin from which it came.

Drywall / Loads WITH Date Stamps 1990 and Newer:

1. **Customer** must provide minimum of 2 pieces of drywall showing the drywall is dated 1990 or newer from **within** the load.
2. **FRR STAFF** will retrieve 3 random samples taken from the load (once dumped onsite).
3. **Customer** must fill in a site-specific drywall acceptance form with scale attendant. Once completed, the samples taken (#2) will be attached to this form and will be kept by Fisher Road Recycling.

Drywall / Loads WITHOUT Date Stamps Or Is Dated Prior To 1990:

1. Analytical (testing) results stating the material is asbestos free will be required for all loads PRIOR to dumping at Fisher Road Recycling. PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU DO NOT HAVE TEST RESULTS OF THE DRYWALL, DO NOT TRANSPORT THE LOAD until you do. See below for testing services.
2. Once test results are verified by our staff; the customer will be directed to unload. **FRR STAFF** will retrieve 3 random samples taken from the load (once dumped onsite).
3. **Customer** must fill in a site-specific drywall acceptance form with scale attendant. Once completed, the samples taken (#2) and test results (#1) will be attached to this form and will be kept by Fisher Road Recycling.

If you are unsure of the year of drywall you have, or it is dated prior to 1990, you will need to have it tested prior to disposal. Please click [here](#) to find out about requirements for bulk sample asbestos testing.

Fisher Road Recycling, through North West Environmental provides its customers a “drop box” where you can drop your test samples off onsite to be tested.
